



SCHEME DETAILS:	The purpose of the scheme is to undertake improvement works to the drainage and surfacing to enhance accessibility for all users of the byways along the byways. The scheme will result in the reconstruction of an asset, such that its useful life will be substantially lengthened. The improvements will consist of, enhanced clearance of vegetation, Improving drainage and putting down an unbound surface such as clean crushed concrete or clean brick topped with road planings to provide a level and all-weather surface and thus enable the route to be used by all user groups, rather than just motorised users. At present the lane is partly naturally surfaced. Some sections are open and exposed to the elements while the majority is enclosed by trees and hedges. The constant use by motorised vehicles has made a section of the route almost impassable for most parts of the year. The lane becomes highly waterlogged, rutted and boggy and is very difficult to negotiate and dangerous to use by all users with instances of users including horses and four-wheel users becoming stuck. The byway forms an important link to many other Public Rights of Way and is part of a larger network of off road routes used by walkers, cyclist and horse riders.






The surface in sections requires harrow and rolling, whilst other sections necessitate surface improvements (as a matter of considerable imperative) by means of laying crushed concrtet nuggets and overlaying with road planings and compacting firmly down (less than 100m) The surface has been extensively damaged in one particluar place due to misues by motorised users. This has aslo been amplified by the challenge of getting stuck and the attempts to get free. Local Farmers have been contacted at all hours of the day to help detach the vehicles from the mud. However the lane is a bridleway and surface damage is casuing a huge issue for local riders of both horses and cycles who have also got stuck. Damage to horses hoofs and straining ligaments have been presented. The bridleway forms an important link to many other bridleways and is part of a larger network of off road routes used by walkers, cyclist and horse riders.


