

Information Sheet for Parties Wishing to Temporarily Suspend a Bus Stop

A Party wishing to temporarily suspend a bus stop or other bus related infrastructure is required to follow the following procedure.

- Cover the permanent bus stop sign and mark the stop “Bus Stop Suspended”.
- Establish a temporary bus stop in a safe location as close as possible to the permanent stop.
- Attach the bus stop flag at the agreed location or put up an A board or similar bus stop sign. The temporary stop must be marked with a sign stating “Bus Stop”
- Erect a temporary bus stop which can be as simple as an A board with the wording “Bus Stop” written
- Post information at the permanent bus stop location directing people to the temporary stop and letting passengers know how long these arrangements will be in place.

On the completion of work, the temporary bus stop sign must be removed and the permanent sign uncovered or reinstated. Any timetable information must be reinstated at the permanent bus stop.

***Note;**

In the unlikely event that no safe alternative location can be identified notices must be put up prior to the bus stop being shut informing passengers of the location of the next nearest bus stop.
