4. Matters Arising from Minutes of the Previous Meeting

The panel considered an update regarding the following matters arising from the previous minutes.

Cllr Robinson queried regarding LCHE22004 – O/s Keene Homes, Broomfield Road, Chelmsford – KEEP CLEAR. Dan Maclean had met with Cllr Robinson at the site and did acknowledge that the problem existed however engineers had assessed the area and there were concerns around pedestrians crossing the footway being distracted. It was agreed that this would be taken outside of the meeting and a call could be arranged with engineers to discuss alternatives.

Regarding the funding for the wayfinding schemes, it was reported that the agreement was for it to be presented to the Chairman's Panel however this process has now change and the £100k now needs to be approved by the LHP panel. The capital budget had been agreed to accommodate for that. Schemed approved by the panel on 18/06/2025.

6. Report on Schemes Awaiting Funding

Following a review of the Local Highways Panel (LHP) process, the allocation of the LHP capital budget was adjusted for the upcoming period. The Panel was requested to submit funding recommendations for a two-year Rolling Programme of Works, with a total budget of £750k allocated to the Chelmsford LHP.

The panel was advised that the Chairman's Local Highways Panel would not be sitting during the 2025/26 financial year and that schemes that were previously awaiting funding decisions from it

	had now been reverted to the LHP's Schemes Awaiting Funding List. The panel agreed to fund all of the projects listed on the priority schemes list. Specific mention was placed on LCHE202041 – Ferrers Road nr, Benbow Drive, South Woodham Ferrers Signalised crossing. Members expressed a desire for the design process to be prioritised, so that a closer implementation estimate cost could be presented at the September meeting. Cllr Robinson expressed that Parish Councils should be made aware that the CLHP budget had been committed for the next two years and that alternative funding methods, such as Neighbourhood ClL and S106 be considered for future schemes. AGREED that the Schemes Awaiting Funding List be noted and that the schemes on the priority schemes list be approved.

CHELMSFORD LOCAL HIGHWAY PANEL REPORT 2 - SCHEMES AWAITING FUNDING LIST

Following a review of the LHP process, the allocation of the LHP capital budget has been adjusted for the upcoming period. The Panel is requested to provide funding recommendations for a two-year Rolling Programme of works, for which a total funding of £750,000 has been agreed for the Chelmsford LHP.

Following the June 2025 Panel meeting scheme funding recommendations to the value of £540,800 have been made. As such there remains £209,200 for the Panel to make further scheme funding recommendations.

Due to the associated abortive costs, only schemes that can be delivered by the end of the 2026/27 financial year can be commissioned. As such the Panel are asked not to recommend funding towards Design Only Schemes or Feasibility Studies.

The Schemes Awaiting Funding, as summarised below, have an estimated total cost of £2,632,700.
