Engineers to look at the entrances and exits across Grove Road from Clarence Road to The Chase. This is a major bus route and should be referred to SEPP as the issue can cause obstruction to buses. Check with Passenger Transportation team to see if they have received any complaints.</p> <p>Wigwag signs school in Barling. Need to allocate funding from this Committee. The signs are often damaged because of where they are positioned, so it wouldn't be appropriate to repair them again. Panel could approve scheme to move the warning signs to a safer position - application to be made to take this to validation.</p> <p>VAS signs. There are 420 VAS signs in Essex to maintain from the LHP revenue budgets. There is still the option of installing new VAS if they meet criteria following a speed survey (any location that has speeds of 5mph over the speed limit).</p> <p>Brays Lane/Ashingdon Road junction. An application was submitted to give priority to this location following an accident involving a child. The road has heavy lorry traffic and is a cycle route. This Potential Scheme List identifies all of the scheme requests which have been received for the consideration of the Rochford District Local Highways Panel. The Panel are asked to review the schemes on the attached Potential Scheme List, finalise their scheme funding recommendations for the schemes they wish to see delivered in 2019/20 and remove any schemes the Panel would not wish to consider for future funding.

The Direct Delivery Gang in 2018/19 achieved cost savings on smaller works for the Local Highway Panels. We would like the panel to consider capitalising on this for 2019/20 by recommending to commission 10% or less of its budget to cover smaller works requested by the County Member which could be delivered quickly by the direct delivery team. We aim to, with your permission, deliver these schemes within a 3-6 month period. To do this we ask the panels' permission to agree in advance any scheme which falls under the direct delivery category and for this to be delivered under Chairman's approval.
