

Public notice

The Essex County Council (Footpath 7 (Dixies foot crossing), Newport) (Temporary Prohibition of Use) Order 2020

Notice is hereby given that the above Order made by Essex County Council, under s14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, has been continued in force with the consent of the Secretary of State for the Department for Transport until 15 July 2021.

Effect of the order: To temporarily close that length of Footpath 7 (Dixies foot crossing), Newport in the District of Uttlesford, from a point approximately 70 metres south west from its junction with B1383 Cambridge Road, south west for approximately 20 metres (foot crossing over railway line known as Dixies).

The alternative route would be Footpath 7, Newport, Byway 2 (Whiteditch Lane) , Bury Water Lane Footway, Footpath 22, Newport, Gaces Acre Footway, B1383 Cambridge Road Footway and vice versa.

The closure commenced on 15 July 2020 and is required for the safety of the public due to insufficient sighting for pedestrians to cross the foot crossing safely and the presence of high speed trains.
