

Duty to Consult On Felling Street Trees

This is a notification that this tree is proposed to be felled. From the date of this notice, there is a 28-day period in which you can provide comments on the proposed tree removal. This notice meets the requirements set out in section 115 of the Environment Act 2021 and section 96A of the Highways Act 1980 on the duty to consult.

Location: First Avenue

Species: Common Pear

Reason for removal: To facilitate the construction of a vehicle crossover at Broughton, First Avenue.

Solutions considered: Tree root working methods and tree pruning methods have been considered however, the level of root severance required would be considered too significant to safely retain the tree when accounting for the heavy lean of the tree stem.

Replacement: Replacement planting is not considered appropriate in this location, given the proximity to existing and proposed infrastructure and the risk of future conflict. An alternative location in the area will be sought. The replacement species has not yet been finalised.
