

The Essex County Council (Oak Road, Rivenhall)(7.5T Environmental Weight Limit) Order 201*

The Essex County Council (hereinafter referred to as “the Council”) in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), (2), 2(4) and 3(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9, hereby make the following Order:-

1. Save as provided in Article 2 of this Order no vehicle, having a maximum permissible gross weight exceeding 7.5 tonnes, shall proceed in Oak Road in the Parish of Rivenhall in the District of Braintree between its junction with the A12 and its junction with Henry Dixon Road other than in a north-westerly direction (hereinafter referred to as “the said length of road”)

2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall apply so as to prevent any vehicle having a maximum permissible gross weight exceeding 7.5 tonnes to proceed in the length of roads specified in the schedule to this order if the vehicle is being used
 - (a) except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform;

 - (b) for fire and rescue, police or ambulance purposes, in the exercise of their duties;

 - (c) is being used in connection with any of the following operations, namely;
 - (i) for the removal of any obstruction to traffic in or adjacent to the length of road specified in the schedule to this order;

 - (ii) for the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction in or adjacent to the length of road specified in the schedule to this order;

4. The Council is satisfied that for preserving or improving the amenities of the area by prohibiting or restricting the use on the roads in that area of heavy commercial vehicles it is requisite that Section 3(1) of the 1984 Act should not apply in relation to this Order.

5. This Order shall come into operation on ***** and may be cited as the Essex County Council (Oak Road, Rivenhall) (7.5 tonne Environmental Weight Restriction) Order 201*.
